Engine air filter \$20.00

STEPS

- 1 Prep and locate the air box - Park the 2020-2024 GMC Sierra 1500 on level ground, set the parking brake, and shut the engine off. Open the hood and locate the engine air filter housing, usually a black plastic box connected to the intake snorkel. Informational DIY**
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- 2 Open the air filter housing - On the 2020-2024 GMC Sierra 1500, release the metal clips, spring clamps, or screws securing the air-box lid. Lift the lid only as far as needed and keep fasteners organized so none fall into the engine bay.**
- 3 Remove the old filter and clean - Lift the old engine air filter out of the GMC Sierra 1500 housing. Inspect the element for dirt, leaves, oil, or water, then wipe or carefully vacuum the housing while keeping debris away from the intake opening.**
- 4 Install the new filter - Seat the new engine air filter in the 2020-2024 GMC Sierra 1500 housing with its rubber seal fully seated in the groove and its pleats oriented like the old filter. Check the entire perimeter for gaps before closing the lid.**
- 5 Reseal and verify - Close the 2020-2024 GMC Sierra 1500 air-box lid evenly and refasten every clip or screw. Confirm the intake tube and sensor connections are snug, then start the engine and listen for an unusual induction whistle that could indicate a poor...**
