PARTS

Engine oil (spec viscosity) \$30.00
Oil filter \$12.00

STEPS

- 1 Warm the engine - Run the engine 2-3 minutes to warm the oil so it drains better.** Park on level ground, turn off, and put on eye protection.
- 2 Drain the old oil - Remove the drain plug with the correct wrench and let the oil drain fully into the pan.** Wait until it drips, not a stream.
- 3 Replace the oil filter - Spin off the old filter, smear the new gasket with fresh oil,** and install hand-tight plus a quarter turn. Do not use a cheater bar.
- 4 Reinstall drain plug - Install a new crush washer and torque the drain plug to the manual spec (usually 20-30 lb-ft).** Look up your year.
- 5 Fill with new oil - Fill to the dipstick or electronic level procedure for your year.** Start the engine, shut off, recheck, and top off as needed.
- 6 Reset maintenance light - Reset the oil-life monitor via steering-wheel and trip buttons,** or use a scan tool if equipped.
